## Call for participation: Non-invasive prenatal testing

### WHAT IS THE OPPORTUNITY?

Health Quality Ontario is currently reviewing Non-Invasive Prenatal Testing (NIPT). The purpose is to understand whether this screening test should be more broadly funded. An important part of this review is to make sure a variety of perspectives and experiences are considered.

### WHO ARE YOU LOOKING FOR?

We are looking to speak to people with any of the following perspectives and experiences:

- Parents who have had a diagnosis prenatally or postpartum of: Trisomy 13, Trisomy 18, Down Syndrome, Prader Willi syndrome, Angelman syndrome, 1p36 deletion syndrome, Cri-du-chat syndrome, Jacob's syndrome or Klinefelter Syndrome.
- People who received a false positive or false negative result from NIPT.
- People who didn't access NIPT in pregnancy but would have liked to.

### WHY GET INVOLVED:

This review will result in a recommendation to the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care about the public funding of Non-Invasive Prenatal Testing. The views, values, and experiences of people affected by this technology are an important source of information that will help the development of a recommendation.
